The Vanguard occasional paper series seeks to advance awareness of emerging Australian defence and security ideas and challenges.

The series engages with emerging and contemporary debates facing Australia's defence force and its military, policy and strategic decision-makers and seeks to encourage broader public discussion.

Submission guidelines

The Vanguard considers original, high-quality research, commentary and analysis that engages with topics of future importance to Australian defence and security organisations.

Potential contributors are strongly encouraged to email their proposal to the editor prior to submission of the paper itself. Submissions are accepted at any time.

When submitting your manuscript or proposal to The Vanguard please also provide:

- a cover letter including the names and contact details of all the author/s, the date of submission and a brief synopsis of the paper (no more than 300 words)
- a short biography of the author/s in the preferred name order
- a declaration statement as detailed below.

Length and style

Submissions should be essays or monographs between 10,000 and 30,000 words and be written for a general audience engaged with military, security and policy matters.

- Manuscripts should be provided in Microsoft Word format.
- Standard fonts and 12pt size are preferred.
- Spell check and proofread your manuscript before submission.
- Use plain English and avoid management speak, military jargon and excessive acronyms.
- Use the Macquarie Dictionary for Australian English spelling.
- For guidance on matters of grammar and style please refer to the <u>Australian Government Style Manual</u>,
- Spell out all acronyms in full when they are first used.
- Ensure technical concepts and terminology are well defined and used in a context that is clear to a non-specialist reader.
- Use sentence style for titles, headings, sub-headings, illustrations and captions.
- Ensure titles are unambiguous and indicate the broad subject matter of the manuscript rather than using gimmicks or puns.

Referencing

The series uses Chicago Manual of Style 17th edition and the documentary-note citation style. See www.chicagomanualofstyle.org for detailed information.

- Do not hyperlink online sources, as The Vanguard is a printed publication, instead provide the full url.
- Access dates for online sources are not required.
- When referencing an online PDF document provide the url it is preferable to the provide the linking page, where possible.

Peer review

While not all papers in the series are peer reviewed, particularly those commissioned by Defence, papers may be subjected to double-blind peer review at the discretion of the series editor. For further details see The Vanguard editorial policies.

Tables, figures, diagrams and images

Tables, figures, charts, maps, graphics and illustrations should be clear, relevant and comprehensible without reference to the text.

- All tables, figures, charts, maps, graphics, illustrations or photographs must be provided separately in appropriate file format and quality.
- Authors should provide appropriate alt-text for all tables, figures, diagrams and images.
- Authors should indicate within their manuscript where they wish supplementary material to appear, including headings and citations.
- Authors are responsible for ensuring they have permission to use third-party copyright materials and must be able to provide evidence of the permissions given.

Declarations

When submitting work for consideration authors should attach a declaration statement confirming the following.

- They are the copyright owner and provide the Commonwealth of Australia with right to publish the manuscript under a creative common copyright and have the authority to do so.
- The work is original and not under consideration elsewhere.
- The views and opinions provided in the submission reflect the views of the author/s and contributor/s and not those of the Commonwealth Government, the Australian Defence Force or Australian Defence College.
- All individuals listed as authors qualify as authors and have approved the submitted version and order of names listed.
- They have gained permission to reproduce within the work any third-party material (figures, photos, illustrations etc.) or material previously published and can provide evidence of the rights provided.
- They have acknowledged any other relevant forms of support that contributed to the production of the manuscript.
- They have no conflicts of interest or financial advantage in promoting the submission's conclusions, findings or research.

- They are complying with the requirements of and declaring any funding received to produce the article or research.
- If selected for publication author/s acknowledge their work will be published by the Commonwealth of Australia under a Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International Licence.

Copyright

The Vanguard is published by the Commonwealth of Australia under a Creative Commons-Attribution 4.0 International licence. This allows users to copy and redistribute the material and to adapt, remix, transform and build upon the material for any purpose, even commercially.

When an article is accepted for publication, authors must agree to publish under the terms of the Creative Commons licence. See declarations above.

Authors must also verify the copyright status of any supporting third-party materials used within their submission and where required gain permission for the reuse and publication of these materials. Third party supporting materials may include line art, diagrams, data, photographs, artwork, charts, tables and figures, maps, infographics, digital images or screen captures from video or films.

Should authors have any concerns regarding publishing their work under a Creative Commons Attribution, they should contact the Centre for Defence Research to discuss their particular circumstances.
