For distinguished command and leadership in action as Commander Joint Task Force 633 on Operation SLIPPER from January 2011 to December 2011.

Major General Angus John Campbell exercised operational command of a joint task force that, while mainly focused on Afghanistan, maintained an enduring maritime security presence, secured the Australian Mission in Baghdad, s33(a)(iii) s33(a)(iii) and fulfilled increased international engagement with a wide range of regional nations. Characteristically a steady presence, his leadership was strategically informed and campaign focused.

Shortly before Major General Campbell's appointment, Australia stood up a substantial commitment as part of the new Combined Team - Uruzgan to enable synchronised Coalition campaign delivery throughout Uruzgan. The bedding down of the new team inevitably uncovered issues that required resolution and reversal, in addition to synchronisation with the wider counterterrorism campaign. Through his visits and continuous engagement, Major General Campbell's exercise of operational command ensured that Australian national expectations were met, that Australian forces were supported and operated effectively, and that benefits to Afghan society in Uruzgan Province were delivered and reinforced.

Throughout 2011, the maturing of Afghan National Security Forces and governance, along with rapidly emerging trends in Coalition forces and campaign design, necessitated a dynamic and flexible approach to the operational environment. Observing these trends, Major General Campbell initiated strategic consideration of the options and timelines and put sound arrangements in place to ensure the necessary agility for Australia to reposture rapidly in response to new opportunities.

Under Major General Campbell's careful influence, and his implementation of the regional engagement plan, arrangements to support the staging and sustainment of forces transiting through and operating from s33(a)(i) and (iii) have evolved substantially and are centred clearly on the needs of those forces to meet their various missions throughout the theatre. The partnering within Australian forces and with both Coalition and s33(a)(iii) has proven to be a foundation of the task force's current sound performance and has been remarked upon by many visitors and returning military members.

Across the wider region, Major General Campbell's efforts have achieved closure on Operation KRUGER in Baghdad, with final transition of security to civilian arrangements. Military engagement with regional nations has flourished under his encouragement with a resultant better understanding of the dynamic circumstances of the region which is central to Australia's security and trade.

Major General Campbell has melded a diverse task force conducting a wide range of operations in dynamic and uncertain circumstances. He has been central to the task force's capacity to handle losses in action. He has advanced Australia's strategic interests and abated substantial risks. Major General Campbell's distinguished command and leadership in action is in keeping with the finest traditions of the Australian Army and the Australian Defence Force.

Major General Campbell led Joint Task Force 633 with skill to deliver significant advances in Uruzgan Province in Afghanistan, while maintaining an effective maritime security presence in the Middle East, and meeting a wide range of regional requirements. His adept engagement with Coalition, Afghan and Emirate partners has delivered many benefits that have been, and will continue to be, critical to task force success. Major General Campbell has, through focused, supportive leadership provided the task force with resilience and resolve to achieve the mission.
