Eligible not for profit organisations may apply for a grant between \$5,000 and \$75,000

Defence Community Grants is accepting applications to support projects with positives outcomes that lead to a strengthened, inclusive and socially connected Defence community as it manages the military way of life.

Important Information Prior To Applying

The Department of Defence can only enter into a Funding Agreement and provide funds to an organisation that is a legal entity. If an organisation seeking funding is not a legal entity, then an eligible not-for-profit community organisation may act as a sponsor and apply on behalf of such an organisation.

Applicants must read the <u>FSFP Guidelines FY 2024-25</u> before completing the application as they contain important information about eligibility, how to apply and management of the grants process.
