Purpose of Collection

The personal information you provide in this application form is collected by Defence to administer export control legislation including the Customs Act 1901, the Defence Trade Controls Act 2012 and the Weapons of Mass Destruction (Prevention of Provideration) Act 1995.

The personal information collected on this form includes your name. The information you provide will be used to assess your application. Defence may also use the information when undertaking compliance activities.

If Defence does not collect the personal information contained within this application form, we will be unable to process and assess your application.

- If no goods are being provided you will not be required to enter a description of Goods and /or technology further in the application process.
- Indicate 'yes' or 'no' if you believe or suspect the technology being supplied may be used in a WMD program, then select 'Continue'.

Provide the code relevant to your goods found within the DSGL, and provide justification for your self-assessed classification, that is, how you made the decision on which code to select.
- Indicate 'yes' or 'no' to the remainder of the questions within this section.



Step 18

- After indicating 'yes' or 'no' to the remainder of the questions in this section, and providing any additional detail as required, you have the option to select 'Add line item'. This enables you to include multiple line items within this single application.
- If your application is only in reference to a single item, select 'Continue'.
