




How to Supply DSGL technology and software within Australia to a foreign person

Step 1

- To commence a '10A – Supply DSGL technology within Australia' application, select the 'Start application' button on the MADE landing page.



Step 3

- Take a moment to read the 'Privacy Notice' to ensure you understand the way in which the Defence Export Controls will collect and use the data you provide.

For this guide, we will select 'seeking to employ / contract a foreign person DSGL controlled project'. Your selection will impact the remainder of the application, and so some of your options may differ from this guide.

- Indicate 'yes' or 'no' as to whether your application is in relation to any technology listed on the Excluded Technology List, and whether your application is in relation to any technology associated with an Australian Military Sales Program item.
