Your circumstances will influence if – and what level of – access to the AUKUS licence-free environment you may benefit from.

<p><u>Scenario 1:</u></p> <p>Transferring goods or technology not on the DSGL</p>	✗	✗	✗
<p><u>Scenario 2:</u></p> <p>Export/supply to countries other than US / UK</p>	✓ <small>Consider if exemptions apply</small>	✗ <small>Trade not occurring within AUKUS countries</small>	✗
<p><u>Scenario 3:</u></p> <p>Export/supply to US / UK <u>not involving</u> ITAR controlled items</p>	✓ <small>Consider if exemptions apply</small>	✓ <small>Consider other eligibility criteria</small>	✗ <small>Not required if ITAR not involved</small>
<p><u>Scenario 4:</u></p> <p>Export/supply to US / UK <u>involving</u> ITAR controlled items</p>	✗ <small>Need relevant ITAR approval from US</small>	○ <small>Does not cover ITAR</small>	✓ <small>Required to <u>transfer</u> ITAR licence-free</small>
<p><u>Scenario 5:</u></p> <p>Receiving ITAR controlled items from US / UK</p>	✗ <small>Need relevant ITAR approval from US</small>	○ <small>Does not cover ITAR</small>	✓ <small>Required to <u>receive</u> ITAR licence-free</small>

Note on Persons/entities who are certified to access the **ITAR exemption** will have already been registered with DEC to access the **Australian exemption**
