

On 16 October 2024 the Australian Government announced a partnership with the Western Australian Government to plan for the development of the Henderson Defence Precinct in Western Australia.

An initial investment of \$127 million over three years has been committed to progress planning, consultations, preliminary design and feasibility studies as well as preparation of enabling works for the precinct.

Transforming the precinct will be one of Defence's largest ever infrastructure projects, estimated to cost billions of dollars over the coming two decades.

The new Defence Precinct will support the build of Army's landing craft, Navy's enhanced lethality surface combatant fleet, as well as the sustainment of our future conventionally-armed, nuclear-powered submarines.

Activities at Henderson will diversify the Western Australian economy, boosting industries in the region, including in engineering, logistics and the supply chain, and creating thousands of jobs over the next two decades.



#### **Defence and Industry Study Course (DISC)** Congratulations to the 2024 Defence and Industry Study Course cohort who

have graduated this December 2024. The 58 participants, made up of 25 Defence personnel and 33 industry representatives, leave the program with valuable experiences, unforgettable memories and mateship. DISC took participants to 13 Defence bases, and they heard from around 100

speakers from the Defence and industry sector over the course of the year. Participants suggested their 'highlights were visiting the testing facilities at Monegeetta, the honest and insightful presentations from speakers such as MAJGEN Jason Blain and the impressive manufacturing facilities at Hofmann Engineering in Perth'. Participants experienced life on a Defence base with overnight stays at both
