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## **Defence Industry Security Program**

The Defence Industry Security Program (DISP) supports Australian entities to understand and meet their security obligations when engaging in Defence tenders, contracts and projects, as well as providing other information to help get businesses 'Defence Ready'.

DISP membership applies to companies working directly for Defence, or as part of a larger supply chain.

Learn more about the program, or meet the DISP team in-person at the upcoming Avalon Air Show this March. DISP and the Australian Government Security Vetting Agency (AGSVA) will have staff on hand at the event to answer any questions.

## Choosing secure and verifiable technology

The ASD has updated guidance on 'choosing secure and verifiable technologies' to include additional insights about supply chain threats for products and services. The publication is aimed at empowering industry to demand that technology manufacturers provide secure and verifiable technologies.

Industry leaders can read supporting executive guidance for assistance with making better informed ICT procurement assessments and decisions, as well as to understand how 'secure-by-design' can reduce the risk to their organisation.

## Strategic Policy Grants Program

Applications are now being accepted for the 2025 round of the **Strategic** Policy Grants Program (SPGP) via GrantConnect, an annual, open and competitive grant opportunity geared towards funding independent, strategic policy-focused research and related activities. Applicants are tasked with either addressing a priority policy question outlined in the 2025 Grant Opportunity Guidelines, or alternatively their own question or topic which aligns with the 2024 National Defence Strategy priorities. This year the program aims to award approximately AUD\$3.5 million in total grant funding.
