On 21 August 2025, Defence participated in the Government Link Lounge at the Supply Nation Connect Trade Show in Sydney, with representatives from several Defence business areas in attendance.

The event provided a valuable opportunity for Defence to connect with hundreds of prospective Indigenous suppliers and promote Defence's **Indigenous business matching service**. This service helps Indigenous businesses by offering tailored advice on Defence organisational structure, contractual arrangements, and opportunities aligned to their specific service offerings.

The United States imposed a 10% baseline tariff, which took effect from 3:01 pm Saturday 5 April AEST.

On 1 August, the US announced that the 10% reciprocal tariffs on Australian exports to the US will remain. Furthermore, the US has suspended the de minimis exemption for all low-value imports to the US from 29 August 2025. As a result, all goods valued at \$US800 or less will be subject to country-specific tariff rates.

Austrade, Australia Post and industry experts recently held an industry briefing on the de minimis exemption changes and how they can affect Australian exporters.
