## REQUEST TO EXTEND COMPULSORY RETIRMENT AGE (CRA) – MAJGEN PL BRERETON $^{\rm s22}$

- 1. It is well known that MAJGEN Brereton has undertaken complex inquiry work to assist the Office of the Inspector-General of the Australian Defence Force (IGADF). MAJGEN Brereton has carried out this work in the capacity as an Assistant IGADF, appointed by the IGADF pursuant to the *IGADF Regulations 2016*.
- 2. MAJGEN Brereton continues to support the IGADF's ability to assist the Office of the Special Investigator, and provides him specialist advice on other matters.
- 3. Defence Regulation 2016, Pt 3, Div 5 Section 23(c) allows for extension of CRA in circumstances where a capability gap cannot be met by standard means. In the current circumstances, the gap cannot be met because of MAJGEN Brereton's unique and extensive experience dealing with the specific inquiry subject matter, and his specialist expertise. The continued service of MAJGEN Brereton is essential to ensuring IGADF can continue to provide high level support to the Ministers, Defence and external Government agencies.

#### COMPULSORY RETIRMENT AGE EXTENSION REQUEST – MAJGEN PL BRERETON<sup>822</sup>

- 1. In 2022, the Chief of the Defence Force approved a request to extend MAJGEN Brereton's compulsory retirement age (CRA) from 27 August 2022 to 27 August 2024. MAJGEN Brereton's extended CRA date is approaching and there is a continued need for MAJGEN Brereton's assistance in connection with the Office of the Inspector-General of the Australian Defence Force's (OIGADF) work.
