

The ethos of the Australian Military is a blend of collective purpose, values and shared identity.

This ethos ensures that the Australian Defence Force acts as a trusted, respected, and effective instrument of national policy, upholding the highest standards in defence of Australia and its interests.

Key Functions of Our Ethos

Purpose:

Clarifies the ADF mission.

Defines Core Values and Principles:

Service, courage, respect, integrity, excellence; guides alignment and newcomer understanding.

Legitimises Lethal Force:

Ensures lawful, disciplined, morally clear use of violence.

Preserves Moral Integrity in War:

Helps navigate moral hazards and retain humanity.

Fosters Trust with Society:

Reinforces military as servant of the nation, not personal gain.

Strengthens Cohesion and Leadership:

Builds unity, loyalty, courage, and selflessness.

Guides Ethical Decision-Making Beyond Battlefield:

Provides framework for complex political, humanitarian, and strategic dilemmas

Conduct in the Profession

State-Sanctioned Lethality with Moral Purpose: Use lethal force lawfully, and ethically.

Unlimited Liability and Selfless Service:

Prioritise mission, puts support in place for comrades, accept potential ultimate sacrifice.

Doctrine of Double Effect and Ethical Warfare:

Minimise unintended harm; operate under laws of armed conflict; uphold humanity even in war.

The Ethos of the Australian Profession of Arms affirms the sacred trust placed in the ADF: to wield force with honour, protect with courage, and serve with a steadfast commitment to Australia's people and values.

Our Ethos

- Serves as a moral compass guiding behaviour and identity.
- Anchors purpose, legitimises force, and preserves humanity.
- Explains why, what is expected, and how to deliver.
- Provides a foundation for actions in Service and enables transition as a part of society


