Sentencing: Facts and legal principles

The complainant, who was a defence member, had been in a relationship with the defendant. The complainant allowed the defendant to record sexual activity between them with consent. In doing so the complainant trusted the defendant not to disclose the imagery to anyone else. In gross breach of that trust the defendant sent three video clips via snap chat to a civilian female showing the complainant and himself engaging in sexual activity. The complainant's face was not in the video footage. The female civilian informed the complainant of the defendant's disclosure of the footage.

He made full admissions to service police and pleaded guilty at the earliest opportunity.

The offence charged is a recent addition to the Commonwealth Criminal Code and carries a maximum punishment of 6 years imprisonment.

The offending was so serious, and involved such a criminal breach of trust, that it warranted reduction in rank and dismissal from the Defence Force.
