Question: I have had applications referred to ASD. Is there a guideline on when an application would be referred to an external agency?

Response: Defence are bound by legislation to consider 12 legislative criteria when assessing each and every export application. This criteria broadly covers Australia's strategic interests and our international obligations. To respond to each criteria we sometimes need to seek whole of government advice.
