

Londonderry Transmitting Station, NSW | Divestment underway



Address: Londonderry Road, Londonderry, NSW 2753

Size: 63 hectares

Approximately 15km north of Penrith, the site was previously used as a high frequency radio transmitting station from 1940. Operations gradually decreased in the late 1990s and it has been closed since 2005. This site was declared surplus in 2024 and is currently undergoing divestment.
