

## Stokes Hill Fuel Installation, NT | Divestment underway



**Address:** 2 Frances Bay Drive, Darwin, NT 0800

**Size:** 3.88 hectares

Stokes Hill Fuel Installation was used from the 1920s until 2014 as a bulk fuel storage facility for Royal Australian Navy operations. The site ceased to operate in 2014 and was declared surplus in 2015.

### Site Functions

This site has been vacant since 2014.

### Site Information

The site is contaminated due to its use as a former Naval fuel installation.

### Site Occupants

### Relocation Options

Nil personnel to be relocated.

### History and Heritage

- Stokes Hill is located within the traditional lands of the Larrakia people.
- The southern portion of the site is a registered sacred site and is protected by the *Northern Territory Aboriginal Sacred Sites Act 2012*.
