



Warradale Barracks, SA | Partial divestment



Address: Corner of Oaklands and Morphett Roads, Oaklands Park, SA 5046

Size: 3.4 hectares

Warradale Barracks is located approximately 11km south of Adelaide CBD. The site contains maintenance areas, workshops, fuel store, and administration, training, logistics and distribution facilities. This site will be partially divested to retain the critical capability, with the exact portions to be finalised through the divestment process.

Site Functions

This site serves as office space, storage, logistics and distribution base for Army Reserves.

Site Occupants

Nil personnel on area to be divested.

Critical Capability

Interdependency with the South Australian Land Swap to deliver the Optimal Pathway for Australia's conventionally-armed nuclear-powered submarine capability, through receiving the personnel and capability from Keswick Barracks which delivered the Commonwealth the land for the submarine construction yard and Skills and Training Academy at Osborne.
