



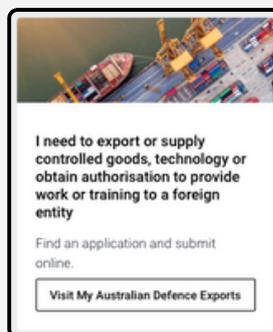
## How to conduct a **DEC Self-Audit**

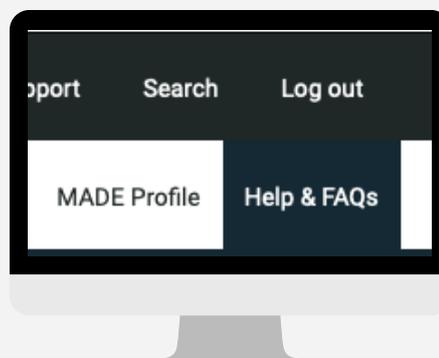

At the dual choice landing page, select the MADE portal option.



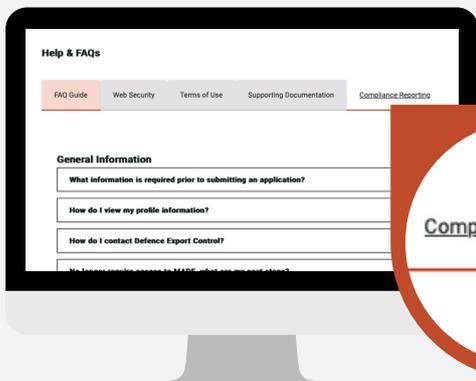

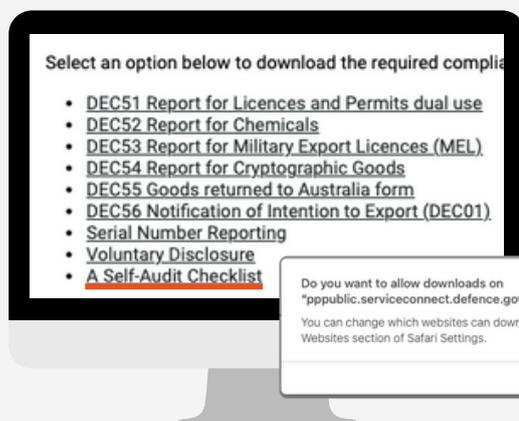




Compliance Reporting

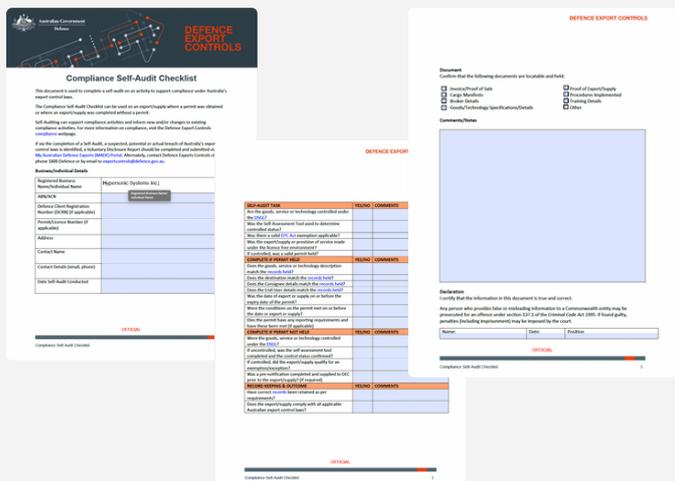

Locate the Compliance Reporting tab and select. This will take you to a list of compliance reporting templates.

Select the Self-Audit Checklist option to download the Checklist as a document to your drive. You may get a prompt asking you to allow downloads, if so select Allow.

You will then be able to start filling out your Self-Audit Checklist!

Should an issue arise (suspected, potential or actual breach of export control legislation), notify DEC Compliance as soon as possible by submitting a Voluntary Disclosure report through the MADE portal.
