New Terms and Conditions

An item [REDACTED] which has only recently been promulgated as Commonwealth policy, is a new requirement that applies from 1 July requiring Defence to include in all new contracts the Commonwealth Supplier Code of Conduct. There are a set of template model clauses on the Department of Finance website, that aren't yet incorporated into Defence templates. Consistent with this new policy we would need Palantir to agree to these before the contract could be signed. Apologies for the late notice, this has only just been brought to our own attention. I've attached the following link for your reference which contains some guidance and the code itself. Hopefully as these are high level principles they won't cause any issues for Palantir, but please let us know if any of the model clauses would be cause for any concern.
