To whom it may concern,

I'm s47E(d) with AAC HQ. After reviewing the recent drafted dress policy, I would like to make the few small following suggestions:

1) In Draft Dress Policy – Items of Uniform, P30, I would like to recommend a clarification box, similar to the 'Explanations' found elsewhere, around the difference between Ranks and Position. An old 2UNI document, where the RCUO rankslide was listed in a column stating 'Rank', has previously caused confusion across several regions. The new manual presents an opportunity to clarify this, by placing an asterisk next to any rankslides which are not necessarily worn by a distinct rank. (E.g. Regional CUO, National Cadet Training Officer and National Cadet Adjutant). **Agreed – I will make it clearer!**

I would also like to recommend that the latter two appear as I have written, as these are the appropriate titles. This also applies to the National Cadet Under Officer. Whilst these are small alterations, they have caused conjecture in the past, and given the opportunity to set a clear standard, I believe it is a small yet useful adjustment.

RSM AAC has released drafts of the updated AAC Dress Policies and is requesting comments and feedback from across AAC that will go into optimizing the final version before it is implemented.

The drafts are being hosted on the [AAC CadetNet PPI Portal](#) under the new 'Policy Updates' section. Feedback can be sent via email to the AAC HQ Policy Branch at [s47E\(d\)](#) until Friday 12 July 2024 .

The most significant changes from the current AAC Dress policy are:

- Full implementation of AMCUs into the policy
- Formal approval of unique uniforms worn by schools like Kings and Monivae College
- A means to track approvals for 'Specific to Unit Items of Dress'
- Inclusion of more details to create a specific Order of Dress for Scottish Dress (limited to 6 units)
- Inclusion of Service Dress/Polyesters as 'allowed' but only with special permission with a strict framework (eg Sovereign's Birthday Parade)

The documents are still in an early draft state and HQ AAC is aware that further proof reading, formatting and image updates are required. With this in mind, feedback should focus on the text and content of the policy.

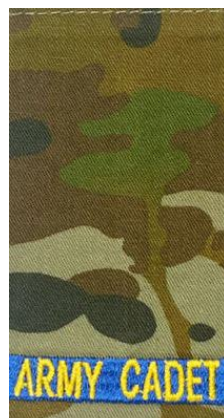

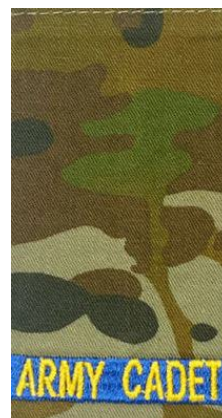
