

PFAS National Coordination Body Key Updates from 10 November 2025 meeting



PFAS National Coordinating Body members agreed to the terms of reference and the strategic priorities over the initial 12 months, to assist the Body in delivering the Government Response to the *Independent Review of land uses around key Defence bases impacted by PFAS contamination*.

Members endorsed the PFAS Williamstown Working Group terms of reference and work plan and community members identified as suitable through an expression of interest round.

The NSW Environment Protection Authority presented on the NSW Select Committee on PFAS Contamination in Waterways and Drinking Water Supplies throughout NSW, advising the Body that representatives would be meeting with the NSW PFAS Expert Health Panel to discuss the Report's findings in due course.

Members also discussed their position on how best to deliver a consistent national approach for the implementation of the revised Australian Drinking Water Guidelines. This item will be considered at a future meeting in order for members to consolidate their positions.
