Responsibilities

Established in October 2012, the WPA Advisory Board ('Board') is responsible for governance of the WPA coexistence framework.

The Board provides the mechanism for government-to-government consultation on the balance of national interests in the WPA.

The Board meets twice a year to receive updates from the Commonwealth and South Australian (SA) government agencies, as well as to endorse proposed amendments to policies and processes agreed to by both governments.

The Board publishes meeting minutes, annual reports and dashboard reports on the WPA website. These provide a statistical overview and commentary about the activities in the WPA for the benefit of all WPA users.
