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Executive Summary

ASP Ship Management has been contracted by the Commonwealth of Australia to provide in-service support to HMAS SIRIUS. At this time, the duration of the contract is fifteen years and is due to expire in 2022. The annual price of the contract for ASP's management services is approximately AUD \$3.0M (GST exclusive).

All routine physical maintenance activities in support of the HMAS SIRIUS In-Service Support Contract (ISSC) are performed by the staff of Australian Companies. In circumstances where there is a requirement to bring in overseas representatives/support to supervise work, this is always arranged through a local Australia based agent and/or supplier on an case-by-case basis. This methodology and commitment will provide ASP Ship Management and members of its technical support network with the impetus to further develop of their industry capabilities in support of HMAS Sirius. The annual value of subcontracted maintenance work is approximately \$9.515M (GST exclusive).

- Supply Support Services, including: end-to-end supply support management; asset and inventory accounting, requirements determination, procurement, management of Reserve Stocks, physical and electronic receipting, storage, delivery, disposal, obsolescence management, and analyses of Supply Support in respect of supportability.
