- b. Production Development and Production All fabrication, assembly, integration and testing will be conducted in Australia;



- c. Training Training and training systems will be developed and delivered using Varley staff and Australian training service providers; and
- d. Integrated Logistic Support (ILS) All ILS activities will be conducted in Australia increasing the ability to sustain all Mission Systems and deliver Through-Life Support services over their life-cycle.

The LAND8140 DFI Project is valued at \$45,519,396 (inclusive of GST), of which approximately \$37,008,093 (inclusive of GST) will be attributed to Australian Industry. Work will commence in the 2nd quarter of 2022 to support these activities, with the expectation that production will be completed by September 2025.
