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Executive Summary

Navantia has a ship building tradition with its origins commencing in 1717 when Spain constructed its first modern ship yard. Working directly with the Spanish Armada, Navantia has designed and or built the majority of the naval vessels that have equipped the Armada for over 300 hundred years.

Since the 1970's Navantia's competitiveness and expertise has earned interest from navies around the world, resulting in a number of Navantia's ships serving with or in construction for countries including Australia, Norway, Malaysia, Venezuela, India, Chile, Morocco, Thailand, Saudi Arabia and Spain. Within Australia, Navantia has established offices in Canberra, Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide and in Perth. The Sydney office provides both the Corporate Headquarters for Navantia Australia and the Sustainment Centre.

The Commonwealth of Australia under a Destroyer Enterprise program has appointed BAE Systems Australia Ltd as the Managing Contractor with in the DDGSPO, to provide the Transition Support Period (TSP) Services for the SEA 4000, Air Warfare Destroyer (DDG) Program.

The Destroyer Enterprise partners include the Commonwealth of Australia, BAE Systems Australia, Thales Australia providing Ship repair services, Raytheon Australia in the role of Combat Systems Integrator and Navantia Australia as the Platform System Designer (PSD).

On the 15th May 2018 BAE Systems entered into a contract with Navantia Australia Pty Ltd for the provision of (PSD) Services associated with the Hobart Class DDG vessels.

The Transition Support Contract (TSP) will be delivered over an initial 5 year period commencing with a Target Budget Estimate (TBE) for each year. Navantia's current contract duration covers 2 months of TBE1 and the full 12 months of TBE 2, 3, 4, 5. Navantia's contract was extended by 2 additional 12 month periods (TBE 6 and 7 respectively) with a combined Contract price of \$50,586,298.00 (ex GST). Currently we are in TBE 7 and the contract price is \$12,050,035.00.

Navantia Australia Pty Ltd, in the role of Platform System Designer, has the following scope:

- a. Contractor management requirements:
 - (i) management, coordination, participation and integration in the DDG Enterprise;
 - (ii) contract status performance obligations and related reporting and documentation management requirements;

- (iii) support, contribution and tasking on asset management and related requirements;
 - (iv) support to the Managing Contractors development of the DDGSP0 TBE;
 - (v) Ad Hoc Services Quotes;
 - (vi) risk analysis and mitigation; and
 - (vii) Continuous improvement and performance management requirements.
- b. Platform designer services including:
- (viii) engineering services; and
 - (ix) general support to DDG maintenance and supply activities
- c. IPMS
- d. Export control, authorisations and compliance requirements;
- e. Ad Hoc Services;
- f. Health, safety and environmental management; and
- g. Support to the Managing Contractor's conduct of Asset Management requirements under the Contract.

Navantia Australia is committed to engaging Australian Industry including SME's for long term support contracts and strategic partnerships, not only for supply chain items but also support services.

Navantia Australia Pty Ltd currently engages with numerous small to medium Australian enterprises (SME's) and is committed to continue on this path to enhance the Australian Shipbuilding Support Industry.
