Executive Summary

Insitu Pacific Pty Ltd (Insitu Pacific) is the prime contractor to the Commonwealth of Australia (Commonwealth) for the provision of the LAND 129 Phase 3 (LAND129PH3) Tactical Unmanned Aerial System (TUAS) capability for the Australian Army.

This Public Australian Industry Capability (AIC) plan details Insitu Pacific's arrangements and commitments for implementing and managing Australian Industry Capability (AIC) involvement for the LAND129PH3 Contract.

The acquisition and support services for LAND129PH3 are provided by Insitu Pacific as the prime contractor under contract number CASG/RASSD/Con9467/1. The contract price inclusive of acquisition and initial support is valued at AUD \$283M. 81% of this value will be delivered by Australian Industry.

Scope of Future Work Opportunities

Insitu Pacific has assumed responsibility for core activity under the contract as the PSI. Having being established in Brisbane, Australia since 2009, Insitu Pacific already has a substantial local capability and well developed network of Australian partners. Along with the identified sub-contractors above, Insitu Pacific is committed to further supporting and developing sovereign Australian capability.

This will be achieved through:

- an expansion in scope of the current sub-contract arrangements;
- ongoing partnering with academia and innovative Australian companies to design, develop and propose to the Commonwealth new capabilities for the LAND129PH3 system to ensure through life technology relevance; and
- delivering on any new acquisition and sustainment support requirements through Australia capability providers where possible;

Areas for future AIC growth are likely to include: system modifications inclusive of new payloads, repairs and deeper maintenance, and engineering/software services including advanced analytics/machine learning and higher level autonomy capabilities.

Industry Engagement

Since its establishment in Australia in 2009, Insitu Pacific has a demonstrated history of engaging and developing Australian Small to Medium Enterprises (SMEs) and supporting their ability to deliver critical capability for the ADF.

Insitu Pacific undertakes a structured approach to industry engagement in Australia. Insitu Pacific's Supply Chain Management (SCM) function identifies new SMEs with the capabilities sought by Insitu Pacific to support the ADF and Asia Pacific export customers. This is achieved through utilising Insitu Pacific's and Boeing Defence Australia's supplier databases and working with organisations such as the Australian Industry Defence Network (AIDN), and the Centre for Defence Industry Capability (CDIC) to identify relevant SMEs. Insitu Pacific takes a standardised approach to supplier solicitation and selection for the procurement of all goods and services to ensure equitable consideration of suppliers and attain value for money outcomes.
