Executive Summary

Boeing Defence Australia Limited's (BDA) Barrukka solution provides the Commonwealth of Australia (Commonwealth) with a locally developed solution for LAND 2072 Phase 2B that draws upon Boeing Defence Australia's proven Australian capability in complex system of systems engineering projects.

Barrukka is architected in Australia using world class Commercial Off-The-Shelf (COTS) and Military Off-The-Shelf (MOTS) products with key integration activities being undertaken locally using Australian engineers and subcontractors. This ensures supportability through life, and continues to build the local capability for System of Systems integration that was established within Boeing Defence Australia for Project Vigilare (Vigilare) and the High Frequency Modernisation Project (HFMP).

Opportunities for Australian Industry for the remaining scope of works will be provided through BDA's Supply Chain Management process including source identification and obtaining multiple quotations for the supply of goods and services

The Contract duration is approximately 5 years with a price of approximately AUD\$487M. Work being delivered by Australian industry is valued at AUD\$285M.

Future Opportunities

BDA may conduct requests for bids for a range of products and services. These vary in complexity, from simple Commercial-off-the-Shelf (COTS) products, to complete systems under major subcontracts. Simple purchases will usually involve a single, one-off Request for Quotation (RFQ).
