### Executive Summary

Fujitsu Australia Ltd (Fujitsu) is one of three industry partners contracted by the Department of Defence to provide a modern, secure, sustainable, and scalable information environment enhancing the current infrastructure-centric approach to ICT to be more agile for future military and business operations nationally.

Fujitsu's specific partnership with the Department of Defence is to provide services including service desk functions, end-user and workstation support, voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) and email communications, collaboration tools, network infrastructure and network services management. The secure reliable business services are to support and sustain three deployed ICT environments within the Deployed ICT Support contract:

- Fleet Information Systems Support Organisation (FISSO) who sustain the Fleet Information Environment (FIE)
- Deployed Information Environment (DIE)
- the Australian Mission Partner Environment (AUS MPE)

The contract commenced on 27 January 2021 with a contract term of three years. The approximate value of the contract at commencement was AUD\$95 million. All work will be undertaken using Australian industries and Australian based, Fujitsu resources.

It is anticipated that at least ten subcontractors will be engaged to provide the contracted services, at some stage, during the term of the contract.
