EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Revelare Hydrosatial is one of nine panel members of the Commonwealth of Australia HydroScheme Industry Partnership Program. The program is designed to deliver quality assured bathymetric data to the Australian Hydrographic Office to support the National Charting function. Revelare is contracted to deliver three hydrographic surveys in the Timor Sea which have project numbers SI 1057, SI 1070 and SI 1071. The Standing Offer Number is SON 3994277 and the total contract price is \$29,267,961.70 (inclusive GST). The project is scheduled to commence in Q2 2025 and conclude in Q4 2027. These projects will utilise only Australian registered businesses and, where possible, will maximise the use of Indigenous owned businesses and the employment of Australian Defence veterans. Accordingly, they will be delivered with the full intent of Commonwealth AIC, and IPP goals.

Under these contracts, Revelare will collect and render bathymetric and oceanographic data in accordance with the project Statement of Requirements. Whilst undertaking this contract, Revelare will subcontract with a wide range of Australian companies that provide services and supplies to support the tasking. A sample of these companies is shown in the following table.

CREATION ENHANCEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF AUSTRALIAN INDUSTRY CAPABILITIES

The work packages required to deliver these surveys was agreed upon and included in the original bid for the contract. The contract was awarded on the basis that the solution and suppliers offered in the bid would be used so there are no upcoming opportunities for Australian companies to become a Revelare subcontractor in support of these survey projects.

Revelare will enhance and maintain existing AIC through the life of this project for all subcontractors.

There will not be any new industry created regarding this project. Industry enhancement will be the responsibility of the subcontractors and will be at their discretion. For example, the major benefactor of this project work is the vessel supplier – One Ocean Group. Since purchase, their vessel *7-Oceans*, has worked nonstop in support of the HIP Program. The income (and profit) generated from this high utilisation has allowed the vessel owner to invest in the refurbishment of the vessels power train, accommodation spaces and utility of the vessel. This ‘re-investment’ in the vessel has had a financial benefit for the Australian firms and businesses who have done this work. It has also benefitted Revelare as the vessel is now more productive, more habitable and more versatile as a result.

This is a similar story for all subcontractors employed by Revelare in support of this project. No less importantly, Revelare (a wholly owned Australian company) has gained much benefit from this project. Revelare was encouraged to grow the business to support the HIP Program. Many millions of dollars have been invested in state-of-the-art survey systems (hardware and software), the development of world class Information Communication Technology (ICT) and the employment and training of



personnel. Without the repeat award of HIPP surveys, the business would fail as it would not have the revenue necessary to sustain the repayment of CAPEX loans or the continued employment of survey specialists that have been employed specifically to service the HIP Program.

Under this program, Revelare provides Defence the opportunity for uniformed personnel or Defence civilians to sea ride with the crew to transfer knowledge and technology and to enhance training and skills development. Revelare also offers these personnel the opportunity to work alongside our personnel in the shore facility to enhance knowledge and skills in the post collection activities of the project.

FUTURE WORK OPPORTUNITIES

For future HIPP related survey projects, Revelare will be requiring services and supplies including vessel provision and operation, vessel fuel and food provision, road freight services and accommodation. The location of these services is unknown and is subject to the project being bid on.

MARKET ENGAGEMENT
