## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LANMAR has been selected by the Commonwealth to deliver technical support services for the NLIS platforms, strengthening Australia's sovereign capability while supporting ongoing system capability, onboarding, and service delivery outcomes. These services will ensure the continued reliability, performance, and enhancement of NLIS platforms. Through this work, LANMAR will contribute to the delivery of resilient, secure, and effective systems aligned with Defence strategy and objectives.

### Operational Support Services

- Coordination of support activities across stakeholders to ensure service continuity.

### Onboarding, Implementation and Training Services

- Implementation support for new features and integrations
- Onboarding of new users
- Delivery of training and effective adoption.

- Change management and control.

### Performance and Maintenance Services

- Ongoing system maintenance, including upgrades, patches, and defect resolution
- Performance monitoring, optimisation, and capacity management.

## CURRENT CONTRACT

The Defined Contract (RFT MSD/RFT/50332/1 Naval Asset Management System Support (NAMSS) ) Value is \$ 25,000,000 (inclusive GST). The project has commenced on 1st July 2025 with the duration of 3 years.

As a 100% Australian owned company, building and delivering Australian Industry Capability (AIC) is central to all LANMAR activities. LANMAR is committed to investing in Australian industry to support the development of sustainable, sovereign capability that strengthens national outcomes in support of Sovereign Defence Industrial Priorities (SDIPs).

LANMAR's intent is to maximise Australian Industry Capability (AIC) outcomes by prioritising Australian suppliers and workforce participation where required and needed across multiple Australian regions, consistent with Defence's AIC program approach.

## SUBCONTRACTED WORK

LANMAR will deliver the above services as the prime contractor, with work undertaken exclusively by its Australian based workforce across multiple Australian regions including NSW, ACT, QLD (multiple) and WA. At this stage, no subcontractors are engaged in the delivery of the services, ensuring direct control, accountability, and alignment with Australian Industry Capability (AIC) objectives.



## CREATION, ENHANCEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF AUSTRALIAN INDUSTRIAL CAPABILITIES

In alignment with SDIP 2 Continuous naval shipbuilding and sustainment, LANMAR will maintain and enhance sovereign Australian capabilities to support the sustainment of the NLIS Platforms ensuring an independent ability to maintain, repair, and support critical systems. This includes strengthening domestic skills in system adoption, sustainment and data management. This approach will be further supported by a knowledge transfer framework designed to ensure that critical skills, processes, and intellectual capital developed during the contract are embedded within the Defence workforce.

## FUTURE ENGAGEMENT OPPORTUNITIES

LANMAR has established a delivery framework to meet all current service requirements under the Contract, with all activities to be performed in Australia by Australian personnel. LANMAR Pty Ltd, as the primary contractor, will execute 100% of the services within Australia using Australian resources. No subcontractors are currently proposed for recurring services, however, should subcontracting become necessary, Australian entities will be prioritised.

LANMAR acknowledges that, over the life of the Contract, requirements may evolve or expand. In such circumstances where scope changes or S&Q activities introduce new or specialised delivery needs, LANMAR will undertake structured market testing to identify capable Australian suppliers. This ensures continued alignment with Australian Industry Capability (AIC) objectives and supports the growth of sovereign capability.

## MARKET TESTING AND INDUSTRY ENGAGEMENT APPROACH

Where potential subcontracting requirements arise, LANMAR will proactively engage and notify Australian industry through the following channels:

- Industry associations (e.g. AIDN, AMDA)
- Office of Defence Industry Support (ODIS) channels
- LANMAR's website and communication platforms
- Targeted engagement via professional networks and direct outreach.

LANMAR will prioritise engagement with Australian SMEs, regional businesses, and specialist service providers that demonstrate innovation, agility, and niche technical capabilities aligned with Defence requirements. Through this approach, LANMAR will continue to strengthen Australian industry participation and maximise AIC outcomes throughout the Contract term
