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Executive Summary

Defence Intelligence Group (DIG) has the requirement to produce Intelligence Mission Data (IMD) to support the creation of Mission Data Libraries that platforms need to maintain situational awareness, survivability and lethality.

The produced IMD supports the ADF and Allied reprogramming centres, specifically it provides All-Source and Technical Signals Analysis outputs that support EW reprogramming activities at Australian and allied reprogramming centres.

SRC Aus Pty Ltd has been contracted by DIG, under contract CASG/ICD/RFT/19269/1, to perform the following activities:

- IMD data production and information collation;
- IMD enterprise training and familiarisation of personnel;
- Provision of secure industry facilities to support data production, training, and the ability to scale up data deliverables as required by the Commonwealth currently in Adelaide and Canberra; and
- Quality assurance of data production.

The contract will run from 1 July 2021 for six years in duration. The total contract value is A\$78.5 million inclusive of GST. This amount has been derived from the values in the fixed price contract in addition to resourced rates for S&Q activities and other subcontractor and product costs. The services and facilities delivered under this contract will be in Canberra and Adelaide.

Subcontracted Work

Total Australian contract expenditure will make up over 99 per cent of the total contract value. SRC Aus' parent company, SRC Inc, will be subcontracted to provide advanced subject matter expertise due to their over 35 years' experience providing operational support for the US Electronic Warfare Integrated Reprogramming Database (EWIRDB) including data mining, intelligence analysis, operational and technical support, and training.

Total foreign subcontract value will be around A\$0.47 million over the six years.
