FOI 096/19/20 STATEMENT OF REASONS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

- 1. I refer to the application by under the *Freedom of Information Act* 1982 (FOI Act), for access to:
 - "1. I request the total cost (including GST) for the information system known as Defence Deployable Restricted Network Light (DDRN-L). These eleven complete systems (plus sparing) were produced in-house by the Australian Public Service for the Australian Army by the Defence Materiel Organisation, Electronic and Weapons Systems Division, Command and Intelligence Systems Sustainment Office (Russell Offices R-3). To assist you in your search the systems were catalogued with Complete Equipment Schedule (NSN) per Reference B. Additionally, the DDRN-L systems were Design Accepted by Land Engineering Agency 04 August 2005 with Acceptance Certificate Number DDRN-L-001 and assigned file number per Reference C.
 - 2. In addition to my request for information regarding the Defence Deployable Restricted Network Light; I further request the complete cost (including GST) for the second generation deployable systems that superseded the DDRN-L. In addition to the total cost I also request the total number of systems built and a copy of the Design Acceptance Report.

Excluding duplicates and drafts of documents."

FOI decision maker

2. I am the authorised officer pursuant to section 23 of the FOI Act to make a decision on this FOI request.

Documents identified

- 3. The Department has undertaken a search of its records, and has identified that no discrete documents existed at the time of your request that contained the information you seek.
- 4. Section 17 of the FOI Act states that where a request is made to an agency, but it is for information that is not available in discrete form in written documents of the agency, and the agency could produce a written document containing the information by the use of a computer, then the agency shall deal with the request as if it were a request for access to such a document.
- 5. I consider that point 1 of your request meets the criteria set out in section 17 and a summary document has been created.

Decision

- 6. I have decided to:
 - a. release one document relating to point 1 of your request in full; and

b. refuse access to documents relating to point 2 of the request under section 24A of the FOI Act.

Material taken into account

- 7. In making my decision, I had regard to:
 - a. the terms of the request;
 - b. the content of the identified documents in issue;
 - c. relevant provisions in the FOI Act;
 - d. the Guidelines published by the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner under section 93A of the FOI Act (the Guidelines); and
 - e. advice received from Capability, Acquisition and Sustainment Group.

Reasons for decision

Section 24A – Refusal if documents do not exist

- 8. Subsection 24A(1)(b)(ii) allows refusal of access if the agency is satisfied the document does not exist. Searches did not reveal any documents relating to point 2 of your request and advice from Joint Systems Division, Capability, Acquisition and Sustainment Group was that no Design Acceptance Report was produced for the GEN2 DDEP Unit variants.
- 9. Based on the above, I am satisfied that no document could reasonably found as matching the description "Design Acceptance Report... for the second generation deployable systems that superseded the DDRN-L." Accordingly I have decided to refuse access under section 24A of the FOI Act.
