



**Intent**

1. This Directive acknowledges Army's recent contribution in developing and based on the CDF decision at s33(a)(i) reference A. The purpose of this Directive is to re-examine the requirement for s33(a)(i) s33(a)(i) and identify the s33(a)(i) s33(a)(i)

**Purpose**

1. The purpose of this Directive is to guide the identification of s33(a)(i) and s33(a)(i) options for the s33(a)(i) and to guide the s33(a)(i) of this s33(a)(i)

**Background**

2. In 1999, following advice from CA, the CDF authorised Army's Special Forces (SF), vide reference A, to s33(a)(i) of s33(a)(i). Since that time a small s33(a)(i) of s33(a)(i) Defence has also supported the development of s33(a)(i) by investing in s33(a)(i) s33(a)(i) under s33(a)(i)

3. The ADF's s33(a)(i) resides primarily within Army's Special Operations Command (SOCOMD). The s33(a)(i) have been recognised as having s33(a)(i) for our current and likely s33(a)(i). Additionally, trends in the s33(a)(i) and the s33(a)(i) from s33(a)(i) and s33(a)(i) of these s33(a)(i) have highlighted scope for the further s33(a)(i). Importantly, this s33(a)(i) has also identified some arrangements, such as s33(a)(i) flexibility and responsiveness.

4. In reference B, the CDF directed me to propose options for s33(a)(i) the ADF's s33(a)(i) in accordance with recent s33(a)(i). Separately he has also directed me to s33(a)(i) within Army.

**Implementation**

5. Recognising the contribution that SOCOMD is making, and is likely to continue to make, to the s33(a)(i) I appoint you to lead on developing options for s33(a)(i). This directive forms my initial guidance to you. To support your study I agreed to the early activation of a s33(a)(i) cell within Special Operations

Headquarters. In the short term, §33(a)(i) will also remain responsive to me for raise, train, and sustain support, thereby negating the need to establish a §33(a)(i) within Army Headquarters.

6. Without limiting your consideration I foresee a §33(a)(i) having §33(a)(i) other supporting mechanisms §33(a)(i) §33(a)(i) as one appropriate policy and and mature raise, train, and sustain arrangements.

7. The following additional guidance is also to be used:

- a. §33(a)(i) are to be used during all stages of the §33(a)(i) §33(a)(i) review;
- b. any special requirements for managing and §33(a)(i) are to be identified;
- c. the mechanisms for §33(a)(i) and how an §33(a)(i) be §33(a)(i) are to be identified;
- d. §33(a)(i) options must conform to the §33(a)(i) and §33(a)(i) and §33(a)(i) options must consider the raise, train and sustain implications.

8. Implementation is to follow a two step process. The first step is for you to develop §33(a)(i) for my, and subsequently CDF's, consideration. The second step will be to implement the §33(a)(i) by CDF. The end state will be achieved when the CDF directed §33(a)(i) has been §33(a)(i) by me as ready §33(a)(i) and with the necessary raise, train and sustain arrangements in place.

#### Liaison

9. You are authorised to liaise broadly within the Defence Organisation §33(a)(i) §33(a)(i) to advance your study. However, you are to seek my approval before you undertake any §33(a)(i) §33(a)(i)

#### Reporting

10. You are to present your initial §33(a)(i) options report to me NLT 30 Mar 07. You are to keep me informed, and be prepared to update CDF, on your progress in the interim. Subject to CDF's guidance I anticipate that you will be required to provide periodic update reports during the implementation phase.

**Funding**

11. I will make additional funds available to support your study should these be required.

**Amendment**

12. Should you wish to have this directive amended you are to seek my approval.

**Cancellation**

13. After considering your report and consulting with CDF and VCDF, I anticipate cancelling reference A and issuing updated §33(a)(i) [REDACTED] on SOCOMD's §33(a)(i) [REDACTED]
