

DEFENCE FOI 154/21/22 STATEMENT OF REASONS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

- 1. I refer to the application by under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act) for access to:
 - "...the following electronically stored information:
 - 1) The total number of Navy Officers that currently hold any of the following positions:
 - a. Major Fleet Unit Commanding Officer
 - b .Major Fleet Unit Executive Officer
 - c. Minor War Vessel Commanding Officer
 - d. Minor War Vessel Executive Officer
 - e. Major Fleet Unit Principal Warfare Officer
 - 2) The total number of Navy Officers from Paragraph 1 that have also self-identified via PMKeyS Self-Service in the "Workplace Equity and Diversity: Ethnic Background" Section as any one of the following:
 - a. North East Asian
 - b. South East Asian
 - c. Southern and Central Asian
 - d. Sub-Saharan African
 - e. Nth African & Middle Eastern
 - f. Peoples of the Americas

I am not requesting any identifiable information (names, PMKeyS numbers, rank, seniority, addresses, contact information, etc) about any of the Officers that hold any positions in Paragraph 1.

FOI decision maker

2. I am the authorised officer pursuant to section 23 of the FOI Act to make a decision on this FOI request.

Documents identified

- 3. One document was generated under section 17 of the FOI Act matching the description of this request. In accordance with section 17 of the FOI Act:
 - a. a written document was produced containing the information by using a 'computer or other equipment that is ordinarily available to the agency for retrieving or collating stored information' (section 17(1)(c)(i)); and
 - b. producing the written document did not 'substantially and unreasonably divert the resources of the agency from its other operations' (section 17(2)).

Decision
