A second FF has been initiated. 2. **Unit action**: The incident reported by $s^{47E(d), s47F}$ is being referred to ADFIS for assessment. A second FF is underway regarding the additional matter.

3. **Unit intent**: Pending the outcome of the ADFIS assessment and second FF, the Unit will pursue disciplinary action. A support officer has been appointed for the female PTE.

4. **IM-A comment**: The respondent is 21 years old and has served for one year. He is previously recorded in AIMS following a threat of suicide on 30 Jul 17; he was assessed as MEDIUM-HIGH risk, received in-patient treatment and returned to work. On 04 Sep 17, further mental health concerns resulted in the mbr being admitted to LHC, where he remains.
