

FOI 259/17/18 STATEMENT OF REASONS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

1. I refer to the application by under the *Freedom of Information Act* 1982 (FOI Act), for access to:

Any documents that show the distribution of random drug tests across the days of the week over the <u>past three years</u> - that is, how many tests were conducted on a Monday, a Tuesday and so on.

FOI decision maker

2. I am the authorised officer pursuant to section 23 of the FOI Act to make a decision on this FOI request.

Documents identified

3. One document, consisting of 216 pages was generated under section 17 of the FOI Act, best matching the description of the request.

Decision

4. I have decided to release the document in full.

 - b. the content of the identified document in issue;
 - c. relevant provisions in the FOI Act:
