





The relevant provisions of *the Defence Force Discipline Act 1982* are contained in subsections 140(1) and (4). Subsection 140(1) provides that "[s]ubject to this section, the hearing of proceedings before a court martial or Defence Force magistrate shall be in public" and subsection 140(4) provides that "[w]here proceedings before a court martial or a Defence Force magistrate are held in a secure place, the appropriate service chief shall cause such steps to be taken as will permit the public to have reasonable access ...". The primary permanent court facility (in Fyshwick, Canberra) does not require escorts for media. However, most proceedings are conducted in the location to which the accused is currently posted. Where a trial is held on a military establishment and the prevailing security requirements necessitate an escort then this is what will occur.
