1. I refer to the application by under the *Freedom of Information Act* 1982 (FOI Act), for access to:

Item 2: Any safety assessment/training reviews that have led to the operational pause of Pressurised Submarine Escape Training.

The Department of Defence excludes private email addresses, signatures, personnel (PMKeyS) numbers and mobile telephone numbers contained in documents that fall within the scope of the FOI request unless you specifically request such details. Defence also excludes duplicates of documents and only considers final versions of documents.
