# FOI 402/18/19 STATEMENT OF REASONS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

1. I refer to the application by Act 1982 (FOI Act), for access to:

'...for the period 1 April 2019 to 10 May 2019 that relate to a request for South Australian Premier Steven Marshall MP to deliver the keynote address at the 6th annual GDAYUSA official Dialogue on Defence Industries in Washington on 8/9 May 2019, including 'significant' emails, briefings, draft speech notes and transcripts.'

Excluding personal email addresses, signatures, personnel (PMKeyS) numbers and mobile telephone numbers, contained in documents that fall within the scope of the FOI request. In addition, excluding duplicates of documents, and documents sent to and from you. Furthermore, Defence only considers final versions of documents.

2. I am the authorised officer pursuant to section 23 of the FOI Act to make a decision on this FOI request.

  - a. To release two documents in full; and

  - e. advice provided by Strategic Policy & Intelligence Group.
