F-35A Lightning II Joint Strike Fighter – Program and Platform Media Analysis Q3 2019 – Q1 2021

Summary

There has been steady coverage on Australia's Joint Strike Fighter Program involvement and F-35A capability over the past 18 months, increasing around major project milestones (IOC, squadron conversion) and international news flash points.

Commentary on US JSF program commitments increased domestic media attention on the future of Australian JSF involvement and the value of Australia's JSF investment to date.

The COVID-19 pandemic generated renewed media interest, particularly by industry publications, in the F-35A delivery and service schedule.

Public affairs messaging and activity around the F-35A and JSF has remained consistent with the high-level strategic messaging of the 2020 Defence Strategic Update and Force Structure Plan.

Positive Engagement

- Neutral to positive coverage from news outlets (print, online, TV, socials) typically rose around key milestones/announceables such as declaration of IOC, BAESA depot induction or delivery of more aircraft.
- Overall, industry journalists and publications maintain neutral to positive trending sentiment when writing on the Australian F-35A capability and JSF program involvement.
- Local media and smaller news publications engage positively with F-35A flyovers, training activities, air shows or other community-based opportunities to view the capability.

Negative Engagement

- Negative coverage out of news outlets (print, online, TV, socials) typically focusses on the program cost/budget, deliverables, reported technical faults, crashes or incidents, schedule delays
- Negative coverage is also spurred by commentary on US JSF Program movements, or other international JSF program news items (spare parts shortages, technical failures) that may affect Australian involvement/investment.

Reporting Periods – Key Insights

Q3 1 July 2019 - 30 September 2019

Coverage and Sentiment

Across this period, Air Force received two **Priority 1** media enquiries including one from the Australian Financial Review, concerning Turkey's removal from the JSF Program. Media response reinforced Australia's cooperation with the F-35 Joint Program Office. The ABC also submitted an enquiry covering F-35 service life, procurement and acquisition timeframes, and suitability of the platform. s47E(d)

Priority 2 media enquiries included another ABC query on RAAF Base Darwin's ability to host the F-35A.

Other notable media at this time included a high profile NYT report describing the US JSF program as 'dysfunctional'. Perceived deficiencies in the capability may have affected the F-35 reputation globally.¹

Negative coverage included a piece by the Lowy Institute on The Interpreter, describing Australia's F-35A purchase as "problematic" and quoted former Air Force chiefs. ²

Positive coverage emerged with industry journals reporting a unit price reduction on the F-35A, and highlighted the critical role the capability plays in the global security environment.³

Air Force received 4 **Priority 1** media enquiries on the F-35A during this period, resulting in a mix of positive and negative coverage. Responses provided to The Epoch Times produced positive coverage with articles on the BAESA maintenance depot and associated jobs growth, and the platform's participation on Exercise Cope North. ¹⁰ The capability received negative coverage in The Australian following US commentary on F-35 engine wear and reported CAF commentary about holding on increasing our JSF order from 72 to 100. 

- As Chief of Air Force I have complete awareness of the full range of the F-35's capabilities. s47E(d)
- Our work has involved a comprehensive series of analysis and activities which has left me without a doubt that this is the right capability for Australia.
- For a program of this size and complexity, it should come as no surprise when technical challenges emerge.
- They emerge <u>because</u> of the robust monitoring the program has in place which then allows us to address those challenges as they are detected.
- No one capability is the answer to generating air power effects. Commentary to the contrary is misguided and uninformed.

Narrative with examples

- The low-observability of the F-35A makes it difficult for adversary systems to track the aircraft, allowing us to detect the enemy and employ air combat effects before they do.
- Despite its complexity, the aircraft was designed with aspects that make it easier to sustain in the field.
- The aircraft provides the pilots with incredible situational awareness which it can share with allied air, land and sea platforms in the battlespace, enhancing everyone's awareness.





F-35 FLEET MECHANICAL/PARTS ISSUES

F-35 General Air Vehicle Operations

- With the large variety of complex systems that make up the F-35, there is often need to replace failed components to make a system serviceable.
- Detailed below are a range of mechanical failures and parts issues for the air vehicle (propulsion listed separately) up until May 2021.
 - Canopy Delamination of transparency coating
 - Caused by cabin air leaking into the canopy frame and causing the internal coating to delaminate
 - Aircraft continue to fly in this condition while awaiting spares
 - New canopies are being manufactured with vent holes in the canopy frame to alleviate the delamination issue.
 - Panel Nutplate Fasteners
 - Disbond of anchor nuts when removing panels
 - Production issue has since been addressed

Defence FOI 396/20/21

- Not an airworthiness issue, causes additional maintenance to re-adhere nutplates.
- Seat Harness Straps fraying
 - Minor fraying as observed on legacy aircraft
 - Not an airworthiness risk
 - Limits are published in technical documentation to support serviceability determination
- Radome damage Multiple bird strikes
 - Several radomes have been damaged/replaced due to bird strikes
- o Integrated Power Package (IPP) Oil leak
 - The IPP is the F-35 version of an Auxiliary Power Unit (APU)
 - Oil leak on the IPP, requiring repair / replace of O-rings
- o Leading Edge Flap Bullnose (Panel 5337) Delamination
 - Impact damage to the Leading Edge Flap
 - Could not be locally repaired; required a complex repair to remediate.

Propulsion Fleet Degraders

- General. F135 issues have garnered international media attention. However, Australia has not experienced these issues to the same levels as other partners with only a few modules being replaced since operations began in Australia. Dec 2018.
- Engine Fan Module
 - Foreign Object Damage (FOD) caused predominately by bird strikes has resulted in Fan replacement.
- Engine Power Module
 - o Bird strikes have resulted in Power Module removal
 - Mainly due to bird debris blocking air cooling vents rather than damage to components.
